

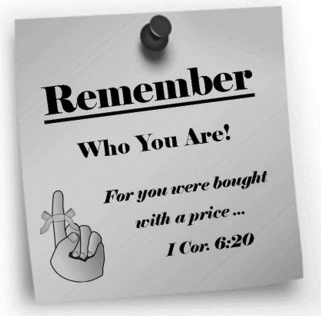

2. Do you sincerely love others without any pretending?
3. Do you hate and stay away from anything that even looks like evil or may influence you to evil?
4. Do you stick like glue to what is good?

**Remember Who You Are**  
(select verses from Romans 12)

**I beseech you therefore, brethren,  
by the mercies of God,**  
that you present your bodies a living sacrifice,  
holy, acceptable to God,  
which is your reasonable service.

**And do not be conformed to this world,  
but be transformed by the renewing of your mind,**  
that you may prove what is that good  
and acceptable and perfect will of God.

**Let love be without hypocrisy.**

Abhor what is evil.

**Cling to what is good.**

Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love,  
in honor giving preference to one another;

**not lagging in diligence,**  
fervent in spirit,

**serving the Lord;**

rejoicing in hope,

**patient in tribulation,**

continuing steadfastly in prayer;

**distributing to the needs of the saints,**  
given to hospitality.
