**1. Be of the same mind toward one another.**

"Think of, that is, regard, or seek after the same thing for each other; that is, what you regard or seek for yourself, seek also for your brethren." (Thayer's Lexicon)

**2. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble.**

- a. Don't be ambitious.
- b. Be godly and humble.

**3. Do not be wise in your own opinion.**

The Point - Do not suppose that wisdom and discernment dwell alone with you. Believe that you stand in need both of help and instruction from others.

2. Have you lost your way and are courting fame and position?
3. Are you a companion of the humble? Are you humble?
